No owners have the same pet, same job, or drink the same beverage. Can you use the following clues to determine which owner has a fish?

- 1. The Canadian lives in the red house.
- 2. The Italian has a dog.
- 3. The American drinks tea.
- 4. The green house is on the immediate left of the white house.
- 5. The green house's owner drinks coffee.
- 6. The police officer has a bird.
- 7. The owner of the yellow house is a nurse.
- 8. The owner living in the center house drinks milk.
- 9. The Brazilian lives in the first house.
- 10. The baker lives next to the one who has a cat.
- 11. The owner who has a horse lives next to the nurse.
- 12. The artist drinks soda.
- 13. The German is a teacher.
- 14. The Brazilian lives next to the blue house.
- 15. The baker lives next to the one who drinks water.
